Teacher Certification & Evaluation

Governor Rick Scott recently signed Senate Bill 1664 and House Bill 7009, both relating to education, into law with an effective date of July 1, 2013. Their provisions address numerous areas, including instructional personnel and school administrator performance evaluations, as well as educator certification and state-approved teacher preparation programs.

[***21st Century K-12 Dance Education: An Investigation of Who, What, Where and How***](#)

National Research Study via an Online Survey

As many of you already know the National Dance Education Organization (NDEO) is

implementing a nation-wide research study aimed at identifying how dance is taught in K-12 public and private schools across the US. The first phase of this initiative was the K-12 Dance Education Data Collection Project (Jan. to Nov. 2013) where teachers completed a short online form with contact and demographic data regarding the K-12 school(s) where they teach dance.

The next phase of this initiative is the implementation of the nation-wide research study in the form of an online survey with much more detailed questions, titled [21st Century K-12 Dance Education: An Investigation of Who, What, Where, and How](#). This survey will highlight what kind of dance is being offered, how is it being taught, who is teaching it, what kinds of credentials the teachers have, what kinds of support, environments and standards are being used, how many student are benefiting from dance, etc.
