National Core Arts Standards Final Public Review

Final public review of the National Coalition for Core Arts Standards (NCCAS) will launch in February. The NCCAS has scheduled a final public review of the draft PreK-12 arts standards in dance, media arts, music, theatre, and visual arts. The review will open February 14, 2014, and close February 28. Teacher Certification & Evaluation

Governor Rick Scott recently signed Senate Bill 1664 and House Bill 7009, both relating to education, into law with an effective date of July 1, 2013. Their provisions address numerous areas, including instructional personnel and school administrator performance evaluations, as well as educator certification and state-approved teacher preparation programs.

Beyond the Test: Mentoring for Artistic Engagement

Registration Now Open!

For the first time ever, the Florida Dance Performance Assessment (FDPA) and National Honor Society for Dance Arts (NHSDA) concert and workshops will be held jointly to shape a two-day symposium titled ***Beyond the Test: Mentoring for Artistic Engagement***. The event will be held at Howard W. Blake High School Magnet in Tampa, Florida on March 1-2 of 2014.

Beyond the Test: Mentoring for Artistic Engagement incorporates protocols aligned with the current research and best practices in performing arts assessment and is designed to enhance students' access to a well-balanced curriculum. Beyond the Test provides students with the opportunity to practice performance, critical thinking, problem solving, and reflective skills that are transferable to other academic areas.

During the two-day seminar, students can participate in ***FDPA***, the ***NHSDA*** Concert, mock audition for college programs, and take master classes with an impressive lineup of professional teaching artists and university professors. Students participating in FDPA will demonstrate on demand and previously prepared choreography to be assessed by adjudicators. Following the review of the
