The government typically does FRSS surveys across all academic subjects including the arts. However, the majority of arts' respondents are for music and visual arts. We believe that dance is underrepresented in these government surveys because the surveys often end up in schools that don't offer a dance curriculum. Our goal is to accurately identify over 2,000 K-12 schools in the US that offer dance. You do not need to be an NDEO Member to fill out this form. Please include the school's address. **NDEO Artistic Merit, Leadership & Academic Achievement Award:
Application Deadline is February 21, 2013**

Background: The National Honor Society for Dance Arts (NHSDA) serves to identify those honor students of junior and senior high school age for nomination for the NDEO Artistic Merit, Leadership and Academic Achievement Award, the highest student dance award in the nation. There are two levels of adjudication: State and National. At the state level, the top applicants are selected to receive a state award and are then forwarded for adjudication at the national level.

New this year, the National Winner of the award will receive up to a \$500 monetary award and a certificate. The Winner is also invited to attend NDEO's national conference to receive the award in person. There will also be National Finalists and Honorable Mentions. Personal congratulatory letters from NDEO's Executive Director are sent to the school district superintendent, school principal and state program arts coordinator.

Award Criteria: Applicants are rated based on the strength of their technical and artistic merit, leadership, and academic achievement. The application includes a 3 minute video of original choreography, four essay questions, overall GPA, recommendation letter, head shot

The student's NHSDA Chapter must hold a current Institutional Membership in the NDEO.

Deadlines: You should hit the SUBMIT button in the online application no later than February 21, 2013. This then triggers an email to be sent to your Chapter Sponsor requesting that they upload the Award Recommendation Letter by February 28th.
